- Instruction from USA Baseball National Team coaches and former Major League greats – 2009 guests included Rod Carew and Frank Robinson
- Event is free to college coaches, recruiters and scouts

- Completed rosters will be available the second week of July
- Every player will see action in four games and participate in a pro-style workout
